## Turtles Class 2024 - 2025

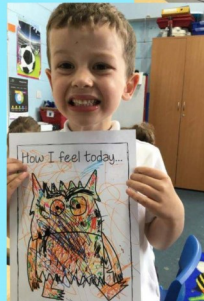


We have read 'The Colour Monster' and designed our own monsters to represent our emotions.

We have had lots of fun junk modelling during our play and learn sessions!





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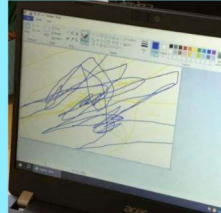
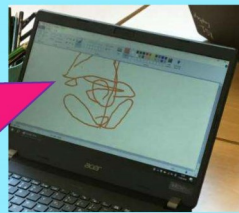
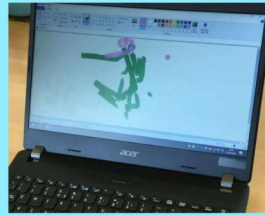
## Seahorses Class 2024 - 2025

In literacy at the start of the term we wrote instructions. We planted seeds before writing the instructions.

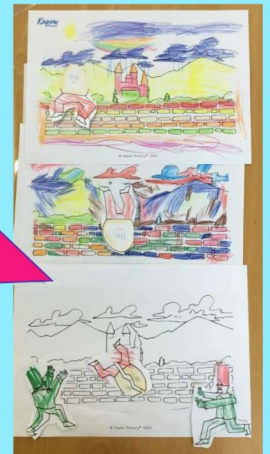


In science we have looked at seasons. WE have explored the weather in different seasons, created artwork for each season and been on an autumn walk.

In Maths we have been learning to write number fact families. In this photo we first put numbers into a part whole model then used that information to write our different number sentences!





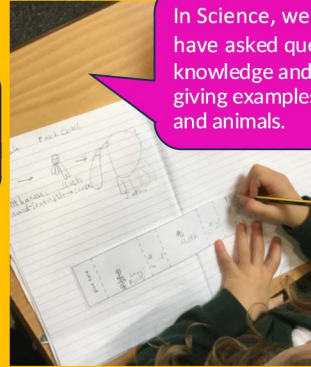

## Starfish Class 2024 - 2025



We have been practising logging onto laptops and accessing different programmes such as Word, Paint and the internet.



In Science, we have focused on habitats. We have asked questions to further our knowledge and recalled some life processes, giving examples of how they apply to plants and animals.

We have consolidated phase 3, 4 and 5 in phonics. We are ensuring we sound talk in our heads and blend aloud when reading.

We have been very lucky to have the musical specialist, Mrs Craven teach us how to use a xylophone.



In DT, we designed and built a stable structure and tested elements of the design and adapt the design as necessary. Next week, we will complete our fairground wheels, ensuring we make the wheel rotate and evaluate a wheel mechanism and adapt it as necessary.

## Whales Class 2024 - 2025

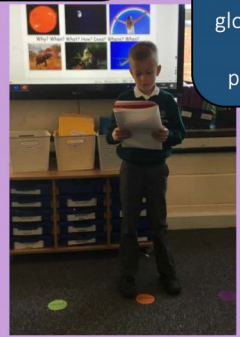


We have had a great time in DT making our Ferris wheels! We explored different ways of creating a stable chassis to help our Ferris wheels turn.



In Music, we have been learning how to play numerous songs on the glockenspiels and creating different notes and pitches with our voices.

We have explored a range of texts in Literacy including poetry and non-fiction. Whales class created their own Autumnal poems and question poems in the style of John Lyons. They performed their fantastic poems to the class.

Shiny objects reflect light really well.



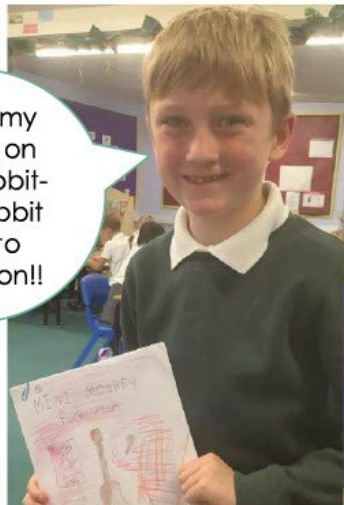
It's best to conduct this scientific test under the desk where there is less light.

Here is my version on Mini Rabbit- Mini Rabbit goes to EuroVision!!



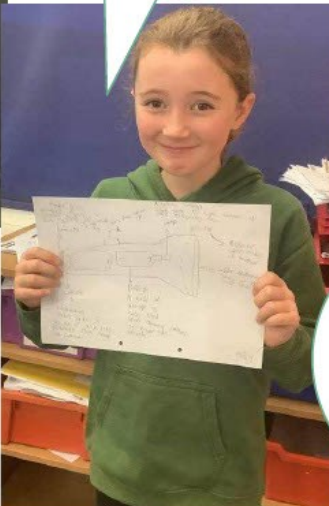
In DT we learnt about torches! Here, I designed my very own torch!

In literacy, we have been writing suspenseful stories.

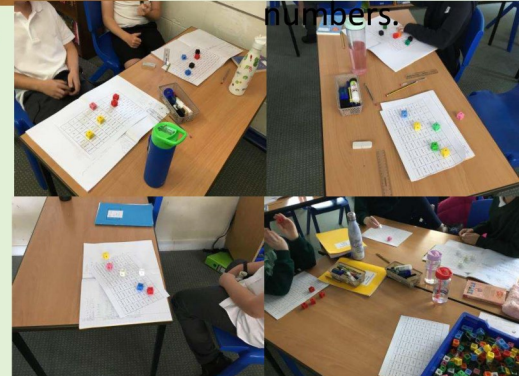
In music, we have been learning to play rhythms as part of samba drumming.

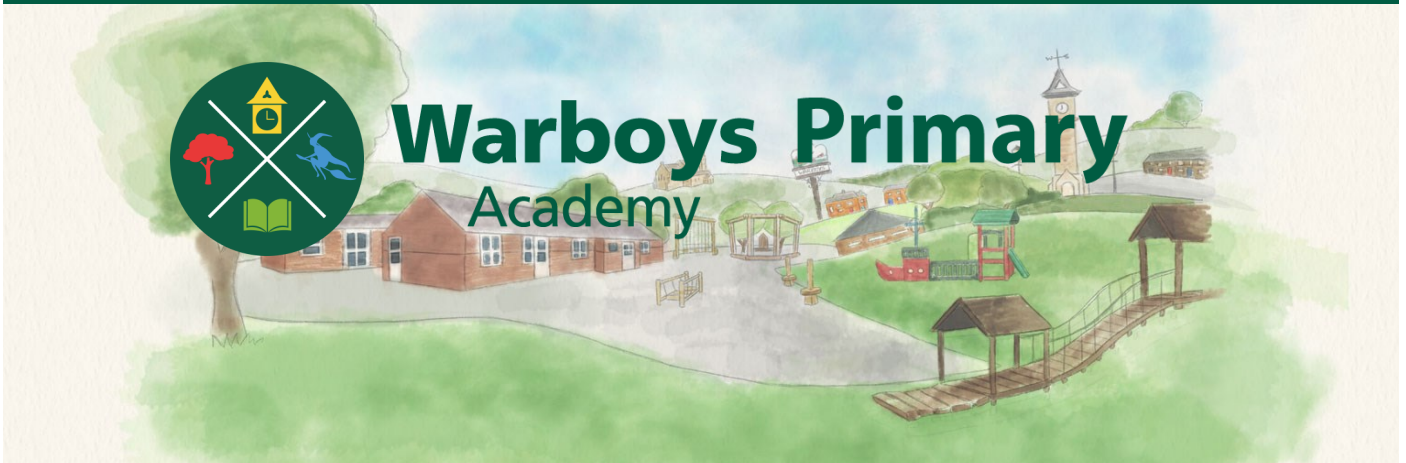

**Did you know that WOVBST can provide financial grants to help with educational costs?**

Young people must live within the parish of Warboys or within half a mile of the parish boundary and must be aged less than 25 years. It can be used for:

- ★ Special sporting equipment or musical instruments
- ★ Education travel to broaden the education and experience of young people
- ★ To allow young people to undergo special training courses that may not otherwise be available to them.
