Dear School Community,

I hope this letter finds you well. I am writing to inform you of some proposed changes to the school day and teaching hours, starting from the Academic Year September 2024.

Recently, the Government updated its guidance on the length of the school day, requiring schools to offer a minimum of 32.5 hours per week by September 2024. In order to comply with this directive, we need to extend our school day by an additional five minutes.

Here are the proposed changes:

- Start Time: The school day will continue to start at 8:45 a.m. (no change).
- End Time: We propose extending the end of the day to 3:15 p.m. instead of the current 3:10 p.m.

These adjustments aim to ensure that we align with the Government's regulations, while minimising disruption to the overall structure of the school day.
